With a red patch

As fast as possible — 10

Before 2 miniature bottles of liquid
2 at top speed
To a scrunched-up ball of paper
To the sound of someone else drawing
A sequence of 5
An unnumbered sequence

Near 3 coloured plastic sleeves – yellow, green, red

Before a 4 bulb sculpture

To some padded infinity dice
As sonnets

With rectangular yellow packages
Timed by an hourglass to a lit block
At a different table
Whilst with a really well sealed light-emitting box in a jar
Getting the feeling for new pens and pencils
Elsewhere to a monarch's candle pot
Like notches
